This Addendum No. 1 is issued in response to questions and requests for clarification received up to April 24, 2019. Except as stated below, all terms of the original RFP remain unchanged.

## **Scope of Changes:**

There are no cannges to the RFP. All terms and conditions of the original RFP remain unchanged.

## **Questions and Answers:**

- Q1: Whether companies from Outside USA can apply for this? (like, from India or Canada)
- A1: Foreign corporations are permitted to participate in the preparation and submission of bids/proposals for Solicitation No. 2019-RFP-03 Transit Advertising Program but may not execute a contract without registering and obtaining a certificate of qualification from the Secretary of State.

California Corporations Code § 2105 states that a foreign corporation shall not transact intrastate business without having first obtained a certificate of qualification from the Secretary of State and appointing an agent to accept service of process. If no agent is designated, the service of process can be made on the Secretary of State.

- **Q2:** Whether we need to come over there for meetings?
- **A2:** It is possible that some meetings with the successful Contractor may not require for them to be present in person, however the Contractor's presence at specific key meetings with SolTrans, including potential local and regional advertising clients, would be required for the successful performance this contract.
- Q3: Can we perform the tasks (related to RFP) outside USA? (like, from India or Canada)
- A3: In addition to the answer given in A2 above, the performance of this contract requires that the successful contractor be present on site when assessing SolTrans' Advertising Inventory, and for the installation and/or removal of advertisments, as well as for any required maintenance.
- **Q4:** Can we submit the proposals via email?
- **A4:** No. All proposals must be submitted as prescribed in Section 3.2 of the RFP.
